Ephesians 2:1-10

You were dead through the trespasses and sins ² in which you once lived, following the course of this world, following the ruler of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work among those who are disobedient. ³ All of us once lived among them in the passions of our flesh, following the desires of flesh and senses, and we were by nature children of wrath, like everyone else. ⁴ But God, who is rich in mercy, out of the great love with which he loved us ⁵ even when we were dead through our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved— ⁶ and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, ⁷ so that in the ages to come he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. ⁸ For by grace you



have been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God— ⁹ not the result of works, so that no one may boast. ¹⁰ For we are what he has made us, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand to be our way of life.

Greetings Little Cedar and Marshall Lutheran Churches,

In our theology class during seminary we were talking about grace, and someone had trouble remembering the old Lutheran saying of saved by grace. She stumbled over her words, "saved by faith, uhh... grace, by faith...saved through grace..." Without missing a beat, the professor blurts out, "just think of McDonalds – saved by grease, through face." Ever since then, I have never forgotten how the phrase goes.

Lutherans really can never get enough grace. Grace is at the center of our Theology. At Luther's time, it was believed that salvation could be earned. Luther's writings contain a lot about grace and faith. This fall we will study some of Luther's writings, and explore those themes of grace, faith, and salvation.

In addition, the theme for the ELCA Youth Gathering in Houston centers around Ephesians 2:8, "For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God." I invite you ponder this free gift. Because we know it is a free gift, we can live with joy filled heart that is ready to serve our neighbor.]
