- -<u>Personnel</u> the committee met and did reviews on all the employees. They gave the finance committee
- recommendations on raises for 2020.

Pastor's Report: GEV is coming to the December 8, worship service to give an update on the camp.

- -Pastor and Tara met with Margaret Neuvirth and Amy DeHoogh concerning elementary religious ed. for the next school year. The Catholics would appreciate using our building for release classes. The council agreed to allow them to use a classroom.
- -Pastor and family are going to Europe for 2 ½ weeks next summer and will visit several religious sites.
