Greetings Marshall and Little Cedar Lutheran Churches,

Well Lent has begun! We begin Lent with our Ash Wednesday service. At the center of our Ash Wednesday service is the imposition of ashes. A cross of ashes is smeared across everyone's forward as a symbol of our sinfulness and frailty. As a part of our imposition of ashes, we also have a time of confession of sins. We know that we are broken, the sinners that we are. And we come forward then to confess our sins

It can be tough to confess our sins; admitting that we have fallen short. However, much of the reason that we can confidently come forward to confess our sins is because we are confident that God will forgive our sins. Martin Luther once said, "Be a *sinner* and sin boldly, but believe and rejoice in Christ even more boldly."

At the center of lent is somberness and sacrifice, but also at the center of Lent is a recognition of our brokenness and sinfulness, and need to be reconciled to God in forgiveness. I invite you during Lent to remember your sinfulness, and SIN BOLDLY! But EVEN MORE BOLDLY, remember the everlasting forgiveness found in Jesus Christ!


