A couple quilts may be set up to tie as part of the project also. All attending worship all are encouraged to take part in helping with these projects which will be done in the Fellowship Hall on September 10th.

-The LYO cookbook has been sent in and a copy has been sent back to LC to proof read.

-<u>Motion</u> by Lahoma Retterath, <u>seconded</u> by Nancy Thalberg that Little Cedar give Tara the opportunity to attend the ELCA Youth Extravaganza conference in Houston, TX in January, with a portion of the payment to come from the balance of the Dean Julifs fund and the remainder of the cost from the lutefisk fund not to exceed \$2000 total. <u>Carried by the majority</u>. This meeting is a preparation for the youth gathering next summer and also offers continuing education opportunities for youth directors.
