The asphalt roof has been replaced, and metal cap, and fascia around perimeter of roof has been replaced as well. You will notice the metal work around that part of the church looks nice and shiny! We do have some repairs to complete on the ceiling of the fellowship hall where water had leaked in. As far as the capital campaign goes. approximately \$40,000 of the needed \$55,000 has been received or pledged to complete the roof. A huge thank you to all who have given or pledged towards this effort. Our church is blessed by you! We give thanks!! If you haven't had an opportunity to pledge or donate to the campaign yet, we'd ask that you'd prayerfully consider! We will periodically update all of you on our progress towards this goal.

The meeting was called to order by Dale and Pastor Jeremy lead us in devotions. The Secretary's report from June was read. Carie gave the Financial Secretary's report with the total offering for the month of April being \$4810. Cause of the Month offering was \$244.75. Luvern gave the Treasure's report and reported a \$1000 donation had been made to the building fund. Jerry made a motion that the reports be accepted as read with Darrel seconding the motion. The motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS: Pastor will be out the next 2 Sundays. Little Cedar's roofing company (Schwigert's) will give us an estimate to do formed steel on the steeple. They have done them in the past. A <u>motion</u> was made by Karen Anderson, <u>seconded</u> by Becky Hartwig, to inquire with Dave Heimer on what he has done previously in cleaning the boiler, what he thinks needs to be done and to get a bid for the work. <u>Motion carried</u>. Discussion on the sealing of the parking lot, which was approved by council in 2013 but was unable to be completed in 2013, due to the weather. Joe will look into this.



<u>Little Cedar Special Meeting Minutes</u>

A special meeting of the Little Cedar Church Council was held on Wednesday, June 25, 2014 @7:30 pm. Members present: Karen Anderson, Pat Hinz, John Jax, Joe Matheis, Mary Schmitz, Tracy Smith, Lani Wolff, Nancy Smith, Millie Weness, and Pastor Jeremy Johnson. Members absent: Becky Hartwig, Tricia Milks, Rod Nordeng, and Cathy Roser.

Pat Hinz opened the meeting with a prayer.

Joe Matheis, from the building committee, gave a report on the Air Conditioner that is not working. Over \$1000.00 has been put into the existing unit and it is still not working properly. The AC unit that is not working is the one that serves the church sanctuary, not the rest of the facility. Joe spoke with David Schmitz, from Schmitz Electric, to get some information on replacing or fixing the current unit. Dave suggested installing something new and more modern. The current unit is a 10 ton unit. New ones would be at 3 ton per unit. We would likely need 4 units, but he suggested installing 2 units to begin with, at an estimated cost of \$4500-\$5000 per unit. We could add the other 2 as we can afford them. One would be installed on the east wall of the sanctuary and the other on the west wall. Everything is controlled by a remote.

After discussion and questions, a <u>motion</u> was made by Tracy Smith, <u>seconded</u> by Karen Anderson, to purchase 2 AC units, from Schmitz Electric, with money to come from the Knutson Benevolence Fund, not to exceed \$12,000 and to be installed as soon as possible. <u>Motion carried.</u>

The meeting was adjourned at 7:55 pm.
