34 Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I am a virgin?" 35 The angel said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be holy; he will be called Son of God. 36 And now, your relative Elizabeth in her old age has also conceived a son; and this is the sixth month for her who was said to be barren. 37 For nothing will be impossible with God." 38 Then Mary said, "Here am I, the servant of the Lord; let it be with me according to your word." Then the angel departed from her.

What is neat of Mary's response is that she is very humble. She doesn't seem to carry herself about like she was worthy of this honor. She doesn't accept the declaration with self-righteousness, but instead seems to realize that in all things God is at work. It is God who is at work!

As we make of these preparations for Christmas, we also remember that it is God who is at work. The birth of God's son, Jesus Christ, is a gift to us. We do nothing to be worthy of this gift. At Christmas, the greatest gift we receive is the forgiveness, love, peace, and joy that is found in Christ Jesus, our Lord!
