FUN FACTS ABOUT THE PSALMS

Contains 150 chapters.

Meaning: "Book of Praises"

Almost half (73 Psalms) are attributed to David.

50 Psalms are anonymous

The Book of Psalms is actually five books. Most Bibles will make this notation within the Psalms

Book 1 - Psalms 1-41

Book 2 - Psalms 43-72

Book 3 - Psalms 73-89

Book 4 - Psalms 90-106

Book 5 - Psalms 107-150

Psalm 117 is the shortest Psalm, with only 2 verses.

The middle chapter of the Bible is Psalm 118.

Psalm 119 is the longest Psalm (176 verses). It is divided into 22 stanzas with each denoted with a Hebrew letter. There is a tradition that King David used this psalm to teach his young son Solomon the alphabet.

The majority of the Psalms are classified as either lament or praise/thanksgiving.

The meeting was called to order by Chair Pat Hinz.

DEVOTIONS/PRAYER: Pastor Jeremy

APPROVAL of COUNCIL MINUTES: A <u>motion</u> was made by Becky Hartwig, <u>seconded</u> by John Jax to approve the May 2014 Council Minutes and the May 30, 2014 Special Council Meeting Minutes, as printed. Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE/RECOGNITION of VISITORS:

A. Thank You was read from Lutheran Social Services for the \$100 sent for the Homeless Teens of Minnesota Fund. Bethlehem Christian Families sent a letter to the church with information on the olive wood figurines they make and sell. The worship and music committee will look this over and see if it is something the church should pursue.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Jaymie Poshusta reported a General Fund balance of \$6324.52. There was discussion on payroll taxes and the daycare. A motion was made by Tracy Smith, seconded by Joe Matheis to transfer \$2000.00 from the Lutefisk Fund to the Daycare Fund. Motion carried. A motion was made by Joe Matheis, seconded by Tracy Smith that Kathy Voigt report at each council meeting whether there are sufficient funds in the Daycare Fund to pay the Daycare Payroll Taxes. Motion carried. Millie Weness has agreed to be the Church Treasurer. A motion was made by Karen Anderson, seconded by Mary Schmitz to accept Millie Weness as the new Treasurer. Motion carried. Council thanks Millie for taking the position and thanks Jaymie Poshusta for all of her time and work put into this job. A motion was made by Joe Matheis, seconded by John Jax to accept the Treasurer's Report as presented. Motion carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

A. <u>Building</u>: Joe Matheis reported that he looked into the Building/Worker's Comp Insurance. Discussion. A <u>motion</u> was made by Tracy Smith, <u>seconded</u> by Karen Anderson to switch Insurance agents, within the same company: Guide One, to Chris Stafford of Stewartville. <u>Motion carried</u>. Joe also reported on the status of the new roof, which is nearing completion. There was discussion on the painting of the fellowship hall ceiling once everything dries up. Will readdress this in the fall. Joe will check with the insurance company if there is any coverage for this. The AC is not working properly and it is being looked into as to where the leak may be coming from. Joe will get some estimates on new systems to have for future reference, if needed. The sound system mixer went out. David Lagerstedt took it to have it checked out to see if it can be fixed. No action was taken at this time, on this.

Summer worship is appreciated by those in attendance.

OUTSTANDING BUSINESS:

A. Audit: The last time an audit was done was in 2006. It was a limited audit and cost the church \$500. To do the same limited audit today, from Hill, Larson Auditors, it would be \$1500(not to exceed \$1500). There was discussion on whether to do this again. No action was taken, will revisit it at the end of the year.

Pet Policy: In the rental agreement it states "No animals allowed. Service dogs are welcome." There was discussion on whether to apply this to all church members, not only to those who are renting. A <u>motion</u> was made by Karen Anderson, <u>seconded</u> by John Jax to extend the policy **No animals allowed, service dogs are welcome,** in the church, to all church members/visitors. <u>Motion carried</u>.

NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Vacation pay for Lynn Johnson: The daycare committee recommended, at their last meeting, to pay Lynn her vacation pay due from 2013, which was 96 hours. A <u>motion</u> was made by Lani Wolff, <u>seconded</u> by Becky Hartwig to pay Lynn Johnson 128 hours of vacation pay, from 2013 and part of 2014. <u>Motion carried</u>.
